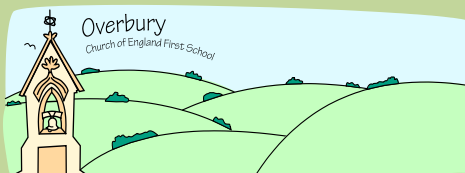

We have been learning about Schools all around the world and found out that some people live in real disadvantage.
