Please note your child will be marked in as late after 8.50am.

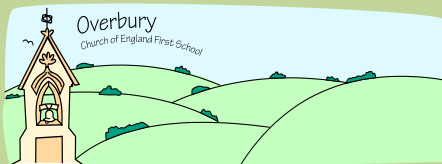
## COVID-19
