Over the last two weeks in Collective Worship, we have focussed on the Christmas Story and how the coming of Jesus was foretold.

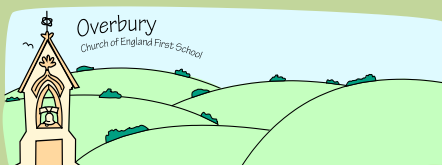
Please ensure your child has a warm, waterproof coat along with a scarf, woolly hat and gloves in school. Please remember to clearly name them all. Thank you.

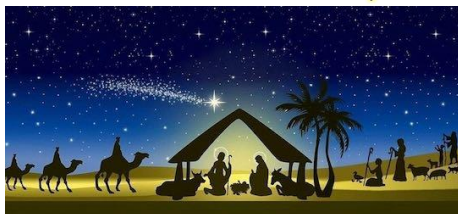
