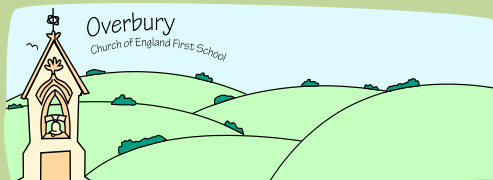

PRESCRIPTION MEDICINES

There is no legal duty that requires school to administer medication; the only exception being pupils on a Medical Care plan who have individual, specific, medical needs requiring medication to treat conditions (eg: cystic fibrosis). Only prescription medicines are to be brought in to school for children to self-administer when absolutely essential (overseen by an adult) and it is not possible to administer at home (eg: antibiotics x 3 can be given before/after school/end of the evening, but we understand 4 times daily requires a dose at school. If it is necessary for your child to receive medication during the school day, you are welcome to come in to school to administer the dosage; however, note that we will not accept non-prescription medicine in school and we will not accept medicines that have been taken out of their original container. 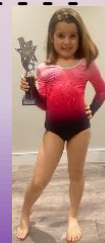
